This model relies on two fundamental ideas in instilling values

The first idea

#### **Priorities**

Based on this idea, the values system is divided into three dimensions based on their priority and importance :

- 1. **Directory** values, with the highest priority.
- 2. Regulatory values.
- 3. Driving values.

#### The second idea

### **Complementarity and Balance**

Is it enough, then, to teach the student only the most prioritized values, namely the directory ones? The answer is no, of course, because values, in their three dimensions, operate within a complementary and balanced framework in the development of the Muslim personality. Therefore, it's not sufficient to teach the student to love Allah without emphasizing the importance of success in life or the mastery of interpersonal relationships. Likewise, it's not suitable to teach success in life without connecting it to servitude to Allah and following the example of the Prophet, and so forth..

For the model to become clearer, it is essential to specify and define the concepts, as well as establish a complementary relationship between them. This will faciliate the teacher's task of instilling values based on this model.





## Concepts

#### First: Concepts

The concept of directory values

These are the values of great importance and influence in building an individual's relationship with Allah, upholding the rights of others, complying with commands, and avoiding wrongdoing.

The concept of regulatory values

These are values that regulate an individual in their knowledge and relationships, and they have an impact on the directory values, either strenghtening or weakening them.

The concept of driving values

These are values that drive individuals towards success, personal development, and psychological balance, preventing them from extremism or negligence. **Second: Relationships** 

Directory values

Directory values are what make the regulatory and driving values meaningful in both worldly and hereafter life. They direct them towards the idea of accountability and invoking intentions. These values also determine the priorities for the Muslim individual.

There exists a complementary relationship between them and the directory values. The presence or absence of regulatory values can either strengthen or weaken directory values. Furthermore, individual's relationship with Allah and their parents, while regulatory

The driving values are influenced by the directory values in utilizing what they acquire from values according to what pleases and satisfies Allah. They also impact the directory values by promoting balance and preventing extremism or negligence.

#### The values system

The values system is constructed in a way that each value includes a number of practices or bahavioral indicators. These aid educators in translating values into practical applications, enabling them to develop activities to achieve. Also, they assist in measuring the extent to which students embody these value.

### Glorifying Allah :

He recognizes the blessings, senses them, and thanks Allah for them.

### • Love for the Prophet عليه وسلم :

He learns about the name of the Prophet, his birth, and his upbringing.

He knows the stories of the Prophet in his efforts to spread the religion.

He memorizes the hadiths that indicate love for the Prophet, and his concern for his community (Ummah).

He learns about the stories of the companions and their love for the Prophet and their defense of him.

He enumerates the reasons for our love for the Prophet, peace be upon him.

He establishes a link between following the Prophet's teachings and his Sunnah, and our love for him.

He memorized some hadiths from jawâmi' al-Kalim (comprehensive sayings).





#### · Servitude:

He maintains the five daily prayers and loves them

He memorizes the morning and evening supplications and observes them

He knows the pillars of Islam, their significance, and applies what is obligatory among them

He understands the virtue of charity and practices it

He knows the virtue of fasting and observes it

He reads the Quran and memorizes portions of it (Juz')

He understands the meanings of Tawakkul (reliance on Allah), seeking help, gratitude, love, fear, hope

He invokes Allah and asks Him for the goodness of this world and the Hereafter

He knows the prohibited transactions in his dealings, according to his age, and avoids them




He visits his grandparents, and fulfills their needs 06


